A BPA is a simplified buying procedure for program offices to place orders without having to go through a formal process with their contracting officers. The NIH BPA is tied to HERMES' General Services Administration (GSA) Mission Oriented Business Integrated Services (MOBIS) contract, GS-10F-0025X for Special Item Numbers (SINs): consulting services (874.1, 874-1 RC) and training consulting services (874-4, 874-4 RC).

Under the terms of the agreement, the NIH can now expedite purchases of up to \$500,000 per order off of HERMES' GSA MOBIS Schedule. In addition, the BPA allows NIH buyers to acquire services at discounted GSA schedule prices.
