



## **HERMES, LLC Awarded Phase II SBIR Grant from the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH)**

The NIMH SBIR program supports small businesses to develop tools and technologies that can advance neuroscience research, translational and clinical research, clinical diagnosis and treatment, and dissemination and implementation of evidence-based research on mental disorders.

**Wilmington, NC.** **H** **E** **R** **M** **E** **S** **Health Education Research, Management and Epidemiologic Services** (HERMES) LLC has been awarded a **3-year Phase II Small Business Innovative Research (SBIR)** grant from the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH) to further develop and field test a clinical and community provider training model to address post-disaster mental health conditions in under-resourced black communities. To reduce individual and community mental health repercussions requires the building of social capital and local competencies while taking into account cultural differences in pathways/access to mental health services and understanding of mental health conditions in black communities. In response to these needs, HERMES' overall project goal is to adapt a community integration training model and use evidence-based practices (EBP) to strengthen local health care provider mental health competencies.

*“This study will demonstrate how emergency response plans can be tailored for different black communities and what the different players – professional, medical, support, and community – can do to prepare a coordinated response to mental health needs that is culturally embedded.”*

HERMES will recruit and train a core team of mental health providers to deliver clinical provider- and community leader-tailored training workshops. Participants will complete

an evaluation follow each training component and pre, post, as well as 3-, 6-, and 12-month follow up knowledge and self-rated competency skills assessments in eight target communities.
